



REIBEL SA – division Belpower Is Proposing Exclusively Green Energy To The Kingdom’s Households And SMEs

Brussels, October 2, 2007. From October 8, the households, SMEs and moderate-consumption industries of Wallonia and the Brussels-Capital Region will be able to enter into an electricity supply agreement with Belpower, the Reibel Group’s energy arm, on terms that are both advantageous and ethical.

A similar option will in theory be offered as of next month to the households, SMEs and moderate-consumption industries of Flanders.

After successively obtaining licences from the regional regulators (CWAPE, IBGE and very recently VREG) making it an operator in its own right on the various segments of the Belgian electricity supply market, Belpower has taken the time to structure its organisation, to amplify its teams, and to enter into alliances with top-flight national and foreign partners. Today, the result is there: the company is in a position to propose to its customers and prospective customers an advantageous overall offer, characterised by competitive tariffs, quality service and a guaranteed renewable product.

Mathieu van Gehuchten, Energy Project Manager, explained it. *“We have first of all opted for fixed-term contracts, of 1, 2 or 3 years. In Brussels, where the law sets the minimal contractual period at three years, Belpower will even be among the first players to offer fixed prices to its residential customers. Without being systematically the lowest, our tariffs will be studied to ensure that they’re always competitive. Priority will be given to the quality of the service: whereas the consumer cannot always know at which altar to worship in view of the complexity of the electricity market, we are firmly committed to the transparency route, by simplifying as much as possible the red tape relating to the supply agreement and by continuing to listen to our customers at all times”.*

Choosing Belpower is also making a responsible choice in favour of sustainable development.

The energy that it produces itself, through its own plants, or that is supplied by its foreign partners, comes from exclusively green sources: solar photovoltaic, hydraulic, wind, biomass or cogeneration.
